



The strategic plans for the Management Department call for a reduction in majors to a level commensurate with our resources and capabilities. We have sufficient resources to support three of our five current majors: Management, Human Resource Management, and Professional Golf Management. The Small Business Management major can be deleted because we do not offer any specialized courses to support this program and we cannot divert resources away from our three core majors to ever do so. Additionally, students have shown little interest in this major and graduation rates have been very low.
